Invitation to Compete

To coincide with its 20th anniversary, BÜHNE acht is hosting a short film competition.

Theme

Eight (written in capitals or not, in letters or as a number)

We are looking for films from all genres. It is not about technical perfection, the focus is on an original and independent idea and how this is translated into film.

Procedure and prizes

The competition will be held on Sunday, 27 November 2016, at 6pm at BÜHNE acht, Erich-Weinert-Straße 2 in Cottbus. The organiser will make a preselection from the entries submitted. Based on the films shown, the jury will award places 1 to 3 who will receive 300, 200 and 100 euro, respectively. The jury will be exclusively appointed by the organiser. Jury meetings are not public. The decisions and judging of the selected group, as well as the jury, are incontestable. Any recourse to the courts of law is excluded. Visitors present can use a voting slip to decide on the winner of the audience award. The winner will receive an award in kind. All of the winners will receive a certificate.

Terms and conditions for entering the competition

All amateur film makers can enter the competition. Film students are not permitted to take part. The short film must have a length of no less than 8 seconds and no more than 8 minutes and must be submitted to the organiser by no later than 30 September 2016 (postmark). Entries must be submitted as files in Quick Time H264 format or as autoplay DVDS. Foreign-language entries must have German or English subtitles. Entries can be sent by post (DVD) or electronically using the free WeTransfer service (no registration required) to: kontakt@filmwettbewerb8.de. The costs for sending are borne by the sender. Two stills must also be submitted to the organiser.

Copyright

All entrants must confirm that the video submitted by them does not violate the right to one's likeness of any person visible in the clip nor any artists' copyrights. An accompanying note prepared by the organiser must be submitted with the film. This note also contains a declaration regarding the images and music used.

Incomplete applications or entries will not be accepted.
